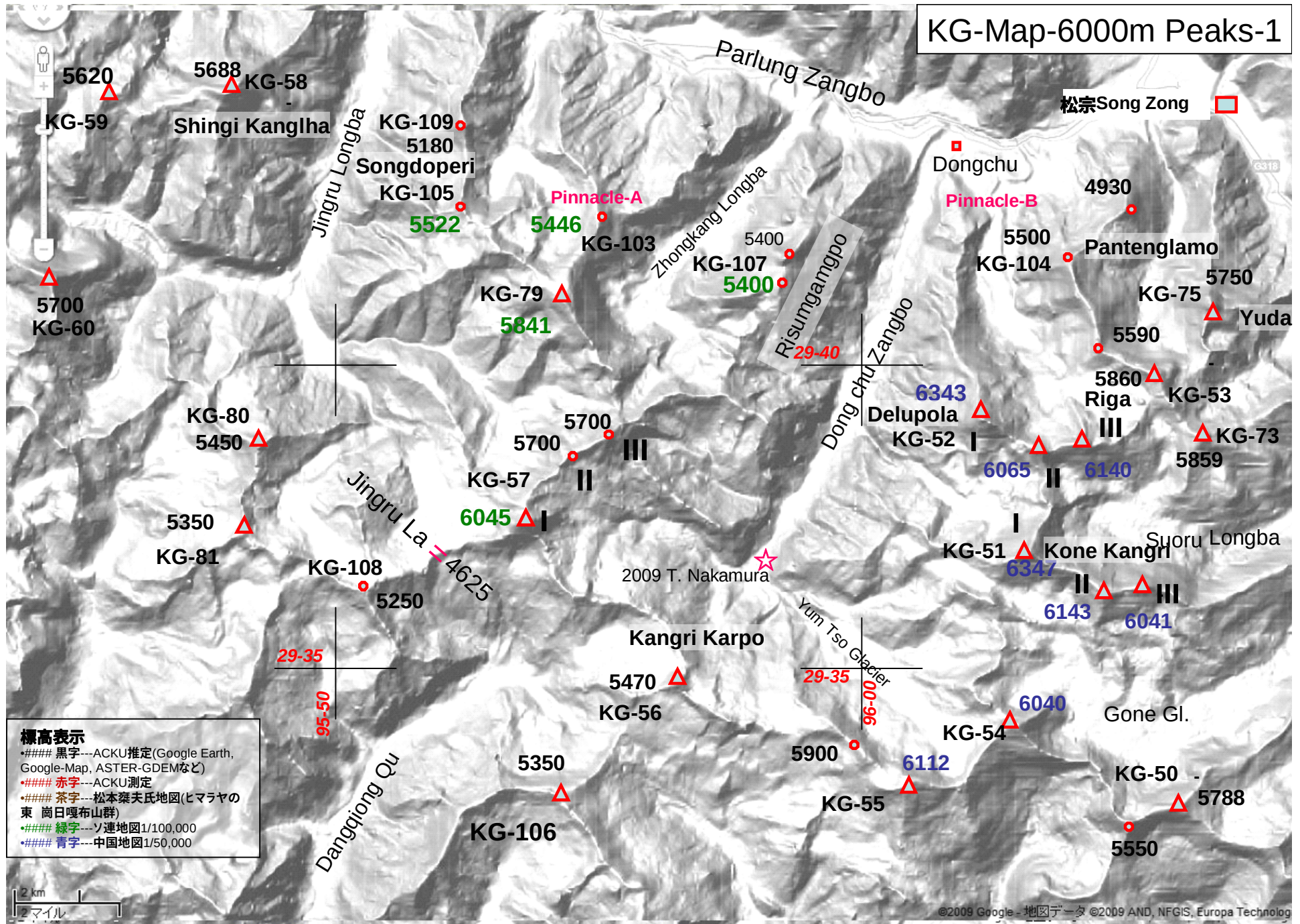

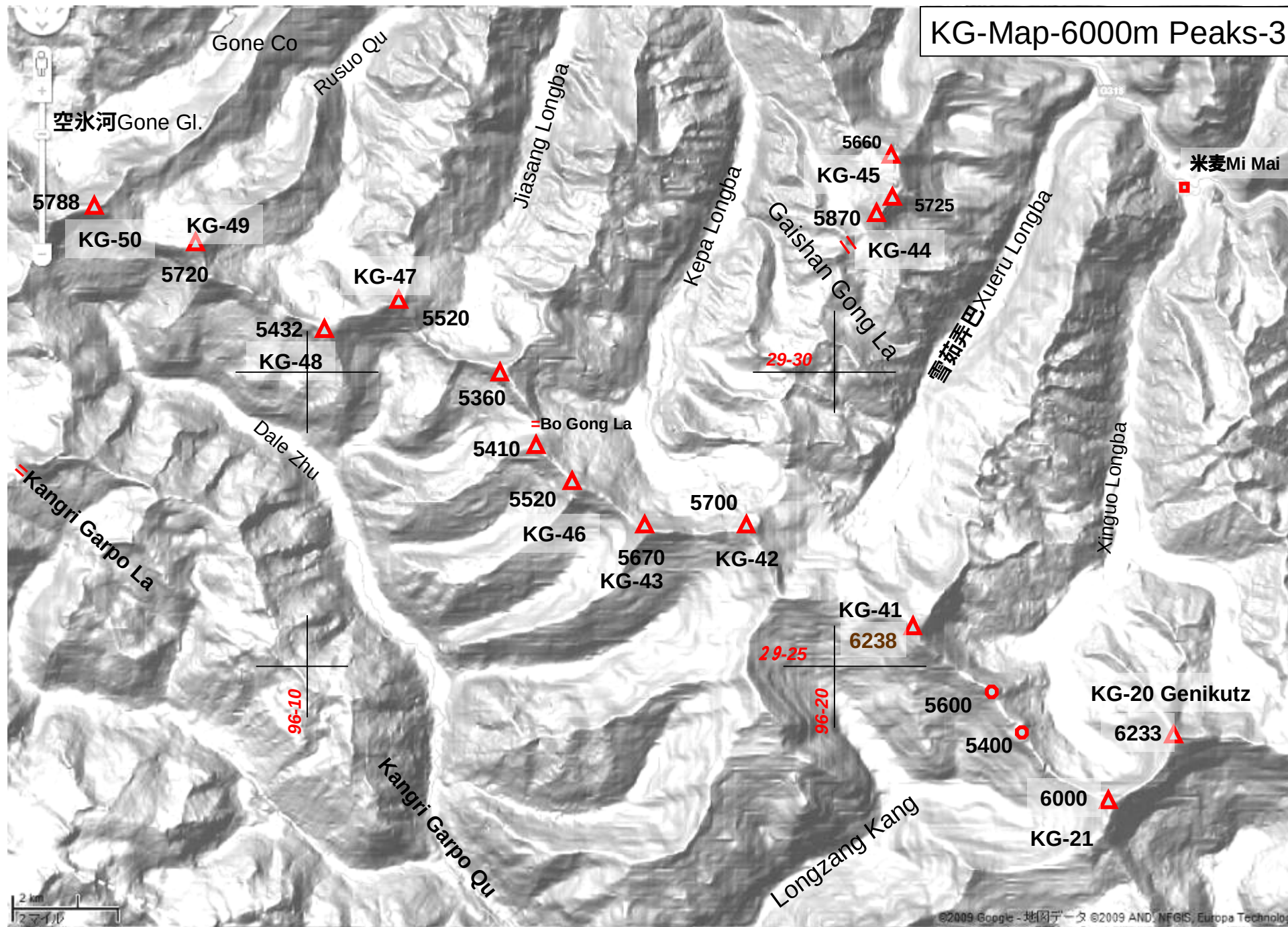

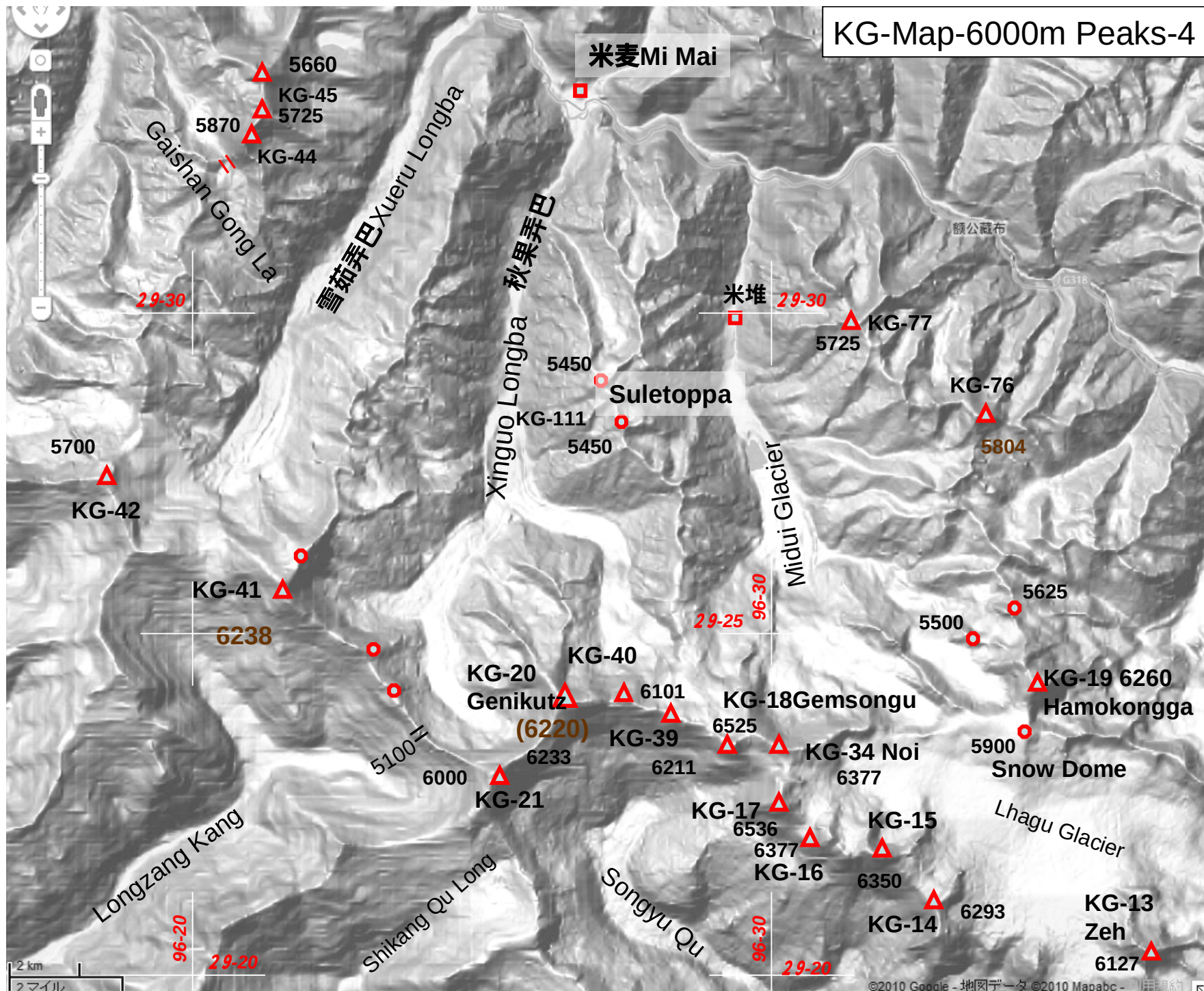

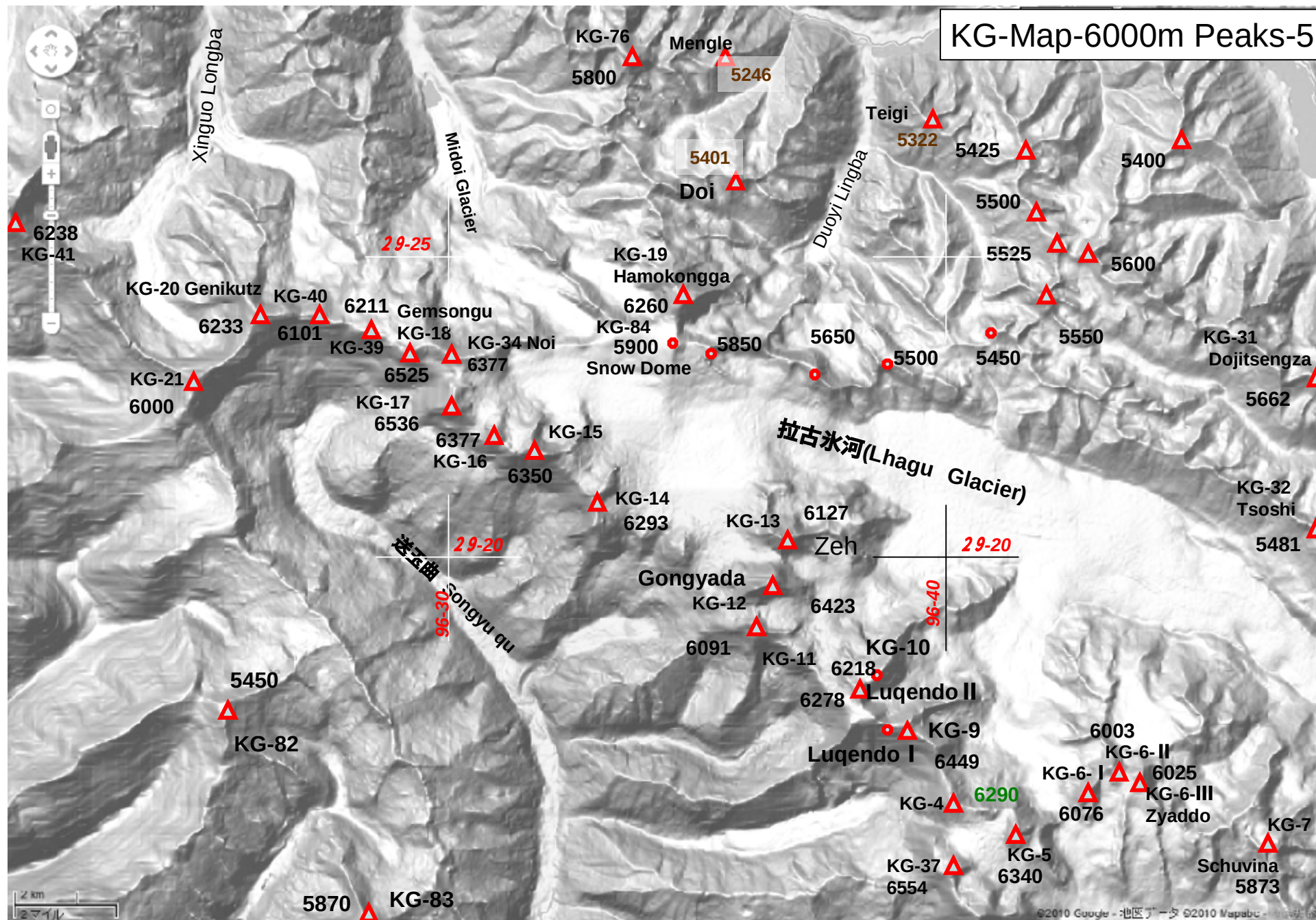


This topographic map displays the Kone Kangri region, characterized by rugged mountain terrain. Key features include:
